

# Congressman Bud Shuster, a Champion for the Central PA Region and Bedford County

Congressman **Bud Shuster**, namesake of the Bud Shuster Highway (I-99) and champion for Central Pennsylvania, passed away in April at the age of 91 at his farm in Everett. The Congressman was central to many successful projects including the \$120 million restoration of the Bedford Springs Resort.

"Bud Shuster had a tremendous impact on Bedford County including the construction of business parks, the recruitment of world-class employers — including the Walmart and REI Distribution Centers — and the restoration of the Bedford Springs," noted **Bette Slayton**, BCDA President/CEO.

"The county didn't have funding for the road, water and sewer infrastructure needed for these major projects. It was a heavy lift. Had it not been for Bud Shuster's leadership and commitment to his constituents, these projects would not have happened. Congressman Shuster leaves an incredible legacy that will impact our area for generations to come," Slayton said.

# **Bedford County ranks first among Pennsylvania Counties in GDP growth**

A December report from the U.S. Department of Commerce's Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA)

found that Bedford County ranked first among Pennsylvania counties in its gross domestic product (GDP) growth from 2020-21. GDP measures economic production, the value of all finished goods and services. The county's GDP grew 14.5 percentage points to \$1.44 billion during the period, led by its

thriving manufacturing sector, which increased the total GDP by 5.6 percent.

**Bette Slayton**, President and CEO of the Bedford County Development Association (BCDA) said, "Bedford County's No. 1 statewide ranking in GDP growth in 2021 is a reflection on our diversified manufacturing base, the astute leadership teams, and talented, committed employees at our local companies."

A fall can be life-changing for any person, but especially for seniors, resulting in injuries like hip fractures and traumatic brain injuries. **Dr. Eunice Yang's** Bedford-based tech company has developed a revolutionary solution to keep seniors safer and to empower frontline healthcare workers to assist patients more effectively.

"OK2StandUP uses a small wearable device to track fine physical motion. Our artificial intelligence program analyzes that data, which can predict when the person is about to stand up," Dr. Yang explained. "Staff receive a push notification on their mobile device and can respond before the person tries to get up unassisted."

"We're a software subscription company. We relocated to Bedford in 2021 because it was not essential for us to remain in Pittsburgh, where the cost of living and operating are much higher," Dr. Yang said. "In addition to being more cost-effective to run a business, the **Bedford County Development Association** has been highly supportive of women founders who are placing a stake in the ground for their business in Bedford."


